Parking just got easier.

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) is in the process of installing new, multi-space Park & Pay Stations throughout the City. Single-space parking meters are being replaced with a new, technologically superior system that will monitor multiple spaces in public parking lots as well as on the street in public parking areas.

You choose how you pay.

At the new Park & Pay Station you can pay with coins, a credit card or by cell phone. To pay by cell phone, simply **pre-register with mPARK by calling 1-888-mPARK-GO (1-888-672-7546) or by visiting www.mparkusa.com**. Park & Pay Stations in select parking lots will offer additional features that include payment with cash bills and the sale of monthly parking permits.

How the Park & Pay Station works:

- A Coin Payment**
1. Enter your space number.
 2. Insert coins for desired time. Use nickels, dimes, quarters or the new golden dollars. The paid parking time for your space is indicated on the machine.
- The machine does not dispense change.**



- B Credit Card Payment**
1. Enter space number, then press **OK**.
 2. Use **▲** **▼** to change time/payment.
 3. Press **OK** to confirm payment amount.
 4. Insert and remove the credit card to complete transaction.

- C Cell Phone Payment**
- Pay for parking with your cell phone by calling mPARK at **1-888-MPARK-GO (1-888-672-7546)** and entering your meter I.D. and parking space number. The first time you use the system you will need to register your phone with mPARK, which is free and easy. You can also register online by visiting www.mparkusa.com. As an added convenience, mPARK subscribers will have the option of automatic text message notification prior to time expiration and can elect to purchase additional time for the space wirelessly. You may only purchase time up to the posted limits for your space.

- D Illuminated Display**
Day or Night: Read important information displayed here.

- E Key Pad**
Enter space number as well as amount of time you wish to purchase by using the keypad. Press **i** for help or to select another language.

- F Parking Information**
Please review parking rates, hours and time limits.

- G Coin Return**
Invalid or unrecognized coins are returned here.
No change is dispensed.

Convenient parking made simple.

The Park & Pay Stations use what is more commonly known as “pay-by-space” technology. This means that each parking space in a designated lot or on the street is assigned a specific number. Enter the number of the space you’re using into the Park & Pay Station and decide what payment option is most convenient for the amount of time you’re planning to stay. This simple system allows you to pay and go -- without needing to obtain a receipt or place any payment verification on your vehicle.



If a Park & Pay Station is not working, simply go to a different Park & Pay Station within the lot or in the same vicinity for on-street parking. These stations communicate wirelessly to register payments, as well as inform LADOT of any malfunction. If you wish to check the amount of time remaining on your space, return to the Pay Station at which you paid and enter your space number to see the remaining time displayed on the screen.

Please keep in mind that other laws and regulations continue to apply regarding parking time restrictions, restricted parking, and tow-away restrictions. Please check all posted signs prior to parking your vehicle.
