REQUIREMENTS:

- Must obtain a HMIS/CLARITY number from a LAHSA approved Service Provider
- Must be the Registered Owner of the cited vehicle
- If a vehicle is Booted/Towed, a person may qualify for CAPP if the Registered Owner pays the Boot/Tow fees and 40% of outstanding citations. The remaining 60% owing can be applied to CAPP
- Each safety violation enrolled in CAPP will require 4 additional service hours beyond the number of service hours corresponding to the amounts due
- Once a citation is enrolled in CAPP, it may not be contested

Participants must complete the community service hours within 90 calendar days from the start of the contract. Failure to do so will result in the contract being cancelled and reassigned to the collection process. Citations enrolled in a canceled contract are not eligible for enrollment in another contract during the 12-month rolling period.

Guideline for Converting Monetary Fines to Community Service:

Amount Owed	Required Service Hours*
\$25 - \$250	6
\$251 - \$500	12
\$501 - \$750	18
\$751 - \$1,000	24
\$1,001 - \$1,250	30
\$1,251 - \$1,500	36
